HP Officejet Pro X Series

With the new HP Officejet Pro X Series consisting of HP Officejet Pro X476/X576 MFPs and Officejet Pro X451/X551 printers, HP has created a entirely new category of printer that can revolutionize the way growing organizations and small workteams in branch or remote offices increase productivity and cut costs.

HP Officejet Pro X Series printers and multifunction printers (MFPs) can deliver up to twice the speed at up to half the printing cost compared with color laser printers. ^(1, 2) This new class of devices is powered by HP PageWide Technology, the next-generation inkjet platform that sets a new standard for small work team printing, producing high-quality documents at up to 70 pages per minute. ⁽³⁾

The HP Officejet Pro X Series offers organizations:

- High-capacity pigment inks with low intervention rates
- Reliable workgroup printing—designed for high volumes up to 4,200 pages per month
- 500-sheet standard input; up to 1,050 sheets with optional tray (4)
- Use up to 50 percent less energy consumption than color laser printers (5)
- Save up to 50 percent on paper costs with automatic two-sided printing, and get free cartridge recycling through HP Planet Partners⁽⁶⁾
- Ability to print from virtually anywhere using HP ePrint, ⁽⁷⁾ and connect directly to the printer without a router with HP wireless direct printing ⁽⁸⁾
- Tap and swipe the intuitive 4.3-inch color touchscreen (available on select models) to print, copy, scan, fax and send digital files (9)
- Compatibility with corporate enterprise networks and management solutions⁽¹⁰⁾
